Bids will be received by the City Auditor, at the office of the City Auditor, until 2:00 pm on Tuesday, May 3rd and then at said office all bids properly submitted will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The project will consist of the following approximate quantities: 2,700' of 8" PVC Watermain, 500' of steel casing pipe, gate valves, fire hydrants and all miscellaneous work necessary therefore and incidental thereto.

Each bid will be submitted on the basis of a cash payment for work. It will be enclosed in a sealed envelope addressed to the above mentioned City Auditor, 103 10th Ave North, PO Box 501, Carrington, ND 58421 and shall be designated that the bid is for "Water Main Loop." The bid shall be accompanied by a Bidder's Bond in a separate envelope in the amount of five percent (5%) of the full amount of the bid, executed by the Bidder as Principal and by a Surety Company authorized to do business in North Dakota. If the Principal's bid is accepted by the City of Carrington and the contract awarded, the principal, within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award, will be required to execute and effect a contract in accordance with the terms of the principal's bid and any requirements and conditions of the City of Carrington.

Bid and Bid Bond must be executed by a principal. Signatures by other than a president, vice president, or CEO, must be accompanied by sufficient evidence (duly executed meeting minutes, resolution, power of attorney, etc.) to indicate that the signatory has the authority to bind the company or organization.

A Contractor's Bond, as required by Section 48-01.2-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, shall be included with the executed Contract Documents. The Bid Security shall be as required in Section 48-01.2-05 of the North Dakota Century Code.

All bidders must be licensed for the highest amount of their bids, as required by Section 43-07-05 of the North Dakota Century Code and a copy of the license or certificate of renewal thereof issued shall be enclosed in the required bid bond envelope.

No bid will be read or considered which does not fully comply with the above provisions as to Bond and Licenses, and any deficient bid submitted will be resealed and returned to the Bidder immediately.

The OWNER retains the right to reject any or all of the bids submitted and to waive any informality in any bid and to hold all bids for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from said date of opening and to hold the three low bids and bid securities for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from said date of bid opening.


The work on the improvements is to commence upon a date to be specified by the OWNER, notice of which will be given to the successful bidder ten (10) days in advance of the start of construction. The Contractor will be required to commence construction, and in an approved sequence, complete the project by November 1, 2022.

ductible, which he said is \$1,000.

He also said that he does not anticipate a special meeting being called to address the incident.

"I did not hear any negative feedback from students throughout the day," said Kuehn.

Wangen said, "The school's procedures for a fire emergency worked perfectly, and they had the kids evacuate as needed."

Added Wolsky, "I can't say enough about the job Mr. Kuehn and his staff did to get the students out of the building until everything was under control. This is truly an ex-

ample of why you practice these things in schools because you never know when they can happen."

"We practice it [fire drills] numerous times a year, and the kids did a great job," Kuehn concluded.

Fire and Rescue responded to another smoke-related call at a residence in southeast Carrington later that night, in which Wangen said that a blower in the house's furnace failed.

Wangen stresses the importance for homeowners to make sure that they have properly-installed and operational smoke alarms in their house.
