REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS TO PERFORM CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR FOSTER COUNTY Foster County will engage the services of a prequalified engineering firm to perform Construction Engineering on the following project in Foster County scheduled to be completed in 2025: The project consists of removing the existing bridge and obliterating the roadway. The project is located 2 miles west and 1 mile south of Grace City, ND. (Sec. 16 & 21, Twp. 147 N, Rge. 64 W) Plans and the proposal are available on NDDOT's Plan and Proposal website on the December 16th, 2024 bid opening - Job 23707. Work to be performed by Consultant includes: Construction Engineering Services: Perform Project Management, Project Administration, Construction Observation, Surveying, and Material Testing and submitting all paperwork required by the NDDOT. Additional services, if required, may be negotiated and supplemental agreements issued based on the consultant's performance, the consultant's proposal and available funding. Firms are invited to submit a proposal for the project listed above. Project understanding, issues, & approach The proposal pages shall be numbered and must be limited to 10 pages in length. Proposals that exceed the 10 page length requirement will not be considered. The cover letter will not be counted as one of the 10 pages. The proposal should list the personnel who will be assigned to work on the project, including titles, education, and work experience. Foster County will only consider proposals received prior to 4:00 PM CST, December 16, 2024. Late proposals will be deemed unresponsive. The consultant's proposal may include an appendix. Resumes, references, a statement of qualifications and other materials outlining experience may be included in an appendix. The appendix will not be considered as a part of the 10 page proposal. Each proposal will be evaluated by a selection committee. Foster County will conduct interviews. The County plans to interview up to three (3) of the most qualified engineering firms based on whose proposals most clearly meet the RFP requirements. Fees shall be negotiated with the successful firm. If the fee cannot be agreed upon, the County reserves the right to terminate negotiations, and then negotiate with the second and third ranked firms in order, if necessary, until a satisfactory contract has been negotiated. All costs associated with the proposal shall be borne by the proposer. The County reserves the right to reject any and/or all proposals and to not award contracts for any and/or all projects. DAKOTA DATEBOOK Turkey Talk

November 25, 2024 - Thanksgiving is coming! And while few decorate for this particular holiday with the same vigor they do for other holidays, there is one important item that almost everyone agrees makes for a necessity for this holiday: Whether it's turkey or Tofurkey, that special entrée is the reason for this season! The Fargo Forum devoted a great deal of ink to the matter of turkeys on this day in 1928. Like us today, they were very concerned about the costs of the holidays. Luckily for them, turkeys were supposed to be sold for a discount-8-10 cents cheaper than they had been the year before. Of course, the year before, turkeys had sold for 45 cents ahead of time, and "a few days before Thanksgiving they were as high as 50 cents a pound-not quite comparable to today's prices.

Of course, one couple from near Watford City wouldn't mind the price turkeys sold for, no matter how high-Mr. and Mrs. Schettle were especially qualified for "talking turkey," since they held a turkey production record. The couple was originally from Germany and had moved to Chicago before settling in North Dakota. They had been farming in McKenzie County for the last 13 years, raising turkeys for the last eight, and over the last four-year period, they had made a record \$100 per turkey hen, which topped any previous record of money made by over \$25. In 1928, Mr. and Mrs. Schettle were preparing to send more than a thousand turkeys to market over the next month, in addition to the approximately 50 "heads of breeding stock" they had sold recently. The turkeys were in excellent condition for the upcoming holidays, and it was predicted that they would each earn at least \$5 a piece. To raise their record turkeys, the Schettles protected them, keeping them well-incubated in the spring and herding them around together under watchful care. Right before the holidays, the Schettles kept their turkeys well-fed on all the home-grown ground barley, wheat and corn the birds could handle. The couple and a hired man also dressed and packed the turkeys for sale themselves. In one day's time, they packed between 50 and 80 turkeys. It was all worth it to get the biggest, best gobblers possible.
